1	<b><u>PRESIDENT'S WELCOME</u></b>  The President welcomed everybody and noted that due to the impacts of Covid-19, the council was unable to meet physically this year, but planned to meet next year during the IFLA World Landscape Architects Summit in Penang in 2021.		
2	<b><u>APOLOGIES</u></b>  No apologies were received for the IFLA APR Regional Council Meeting 2020.		
3	<b><u>DELEGATE, OBSERVER AND SECRETARIAT INTRODUCTIONS</u></b>  Delegates, observers, and the secretariat all gave a brief introduction.		
4	<b><u>CONFIRMATION OF LAST COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES</u></b>  Prof Zheng Xiaodi (CHSLA) highlighted the reason that CHSLA was unable to attend the last council meeting was due to edits required to the list of associations on the registration website of the meeting, which were not able to be completed in time (due to technical difficulties) to allow their representatives to attend the meeting. The edits were required under the One China policy that CHSLA must follow, which meant that their representatives could not take part in the regional council meeting and congress.		

	<p>Hon Secretary, Assoc. Prof. Mike Barthelmeh, agreed with a statement from CHSLA that as a non-political organisation IFLA APR has no view on the one China policy. He noted that indeed IFLA APR recognises that CHSLA is bound by a One China Policy in line with the 2005 agreement with IFLA.</p> <p>The minutes of the last council meeting were confirmed subject to the modification of the entry in regard to the non-attendance by CHSLA at the 2019 Cebu meeting. <p><b>7</b></p>	<p><b><u>PRESIDENT'S REPORT</u></b></p> <p>The President, Mr. Fumiaki Takano presented his report which referred to some new initiatives due to the pandemic: East Japan Big Earthquake 2011 Recovery Visit Symposium, Reforming Landscape Architecture Practice Post Pandemic by ILAM and Landscape Architect without Borders Activities by Ms Kotchakorn, Chairwoman of Landscape Architect without Borders.</p> <p>The President also extended his invitation to non-member countries to join the council meeting as observers. Representatives from the Kingdom of Tonga, the Republic of Palau, Cambodia, and Vietnam introduced themselves to the members of council. This invitation has the aim to expand our community, and share knowledge and thinking in common areas of interest.</p>
