PURPOSE OF THE REPORT.

This is a report for the IFLA APR EAA works in this annual section of 2021–2022.

SUMMARY OF THE REPORT (UP TO 100 WORDS).

The tasks for 2020-2021 include: 1) enhancing the regional LA education coordination network; 2) organizing events such as the International Landscape architect's symposium and the 2022 International Garden Construction Festival; 3) completing the jury works of three international competitions; 4) developing and promoting pedagogies such as the construction technology of robotic arms and the carbon footprint calculation method in BLA courses. The report also includes EAA's plans for the next annual section.

REPORT.

- Through lectures, websites, and other public methods, we have continuously brought education leaders to the regional LA education coordination network that use a slack working group for daily communication.
- We conducted the series of Master Lectures and the International Landscape architect's symposium in September to November 2021. They were promoted by the website of IFLA APR.
- We have been holding the design competition for the 2022 International Garden Construction Festival from January to July 2022.
- In November 2021, ZHENG Xi attended the 2021 LEaP Conference held by PRC, PRBLA as a resource speaker on behalf of the IFLA APR EAA.
- ZHENG Xi served as the jury member for the LI Award, IFLA AAPME Award, and the IFLA Student Competition.
- In July 2021, we introduced the construction technology of robotic arms in the international summer course, with a view to promoting it in the region.
- We have established a carbon footprint calculation method that includes the whole elements and life cycle of landscape architecture. The application and promotion of green space carbon footprint evaluation is to be carried out through web platform and apps.

RECOMMENDATIONS (MOTIONS TO VOTE):

IFLA APR EAA's plans include the following.

- We will continue to expand the membership of APR regional institutions through various public channels and strive to hold an exchange meeting of Asia-Pacific landscape architecture institutions this year to exchange teaching experiences online.
- This year we will continue the series of International Landscape Architecture Master Lectures (expected to be 5 lectures).
- IFLA APR EAA will work with IFLA EAA, the other IFLA APR committees and working groups to continue to promote landscape architecture education in the Asia-Pacific region, to build bridges and create easily accessible resources and platforms to showcase capabilities in the region affected by the epidemic.
