1. After World Council 2023, expected restructuring in the structure of IFLA, the Committees, and Working Groups at the World level.

2. After World Council 2023, it has been approved a Global Recognition Program for Landscape architecture education (bachelor programs).

#### 1. Restructuring

- Establishment of a Corporate Governance Revision Working Group (CGRWG)
  mandated to present a revised constitution and by-laws for the next World Council for approval.
- Establishment of a Congress Revision Working Group (CRWG)
  mandated to present a revised operational model for the next World Council for approval.
- Establishment of a Standing Committee Revision Working Group (SCRWG), mandated to present a revised structure of standing committees and WGs for the next World Council for approval.



Key items to report at the APR Regional Council

#### 1. Restructuring

- Consequently, positions will be available for interested delegates upon candidature at the:

Corporate Governance Revision Working Group (CGRWG)

Congress Revision Working Group (CRWG)

Standing Committee Revision Working Group (SCRWG)

- At the same time, IFLA APR region should consider **HOW DO WE PARTICIPATE** the ongoing transformation, especially in consideration of the restructuring of EAA-CER-PPP-FBP standing committees and working groups.



Key items to report at the APR Regional Council

#### 2. Education Recognition

- In the APR Region, we have an **Accreditation and Recognition Program** V2 active since 2018, with IPB Bogor Indonesia being the first program to achieve renewal of accreditation in 2023;
- Our region was strongly participating in the development of the Global Recognition Program, due to the regional experience and a pilot study in the region, and now this is approved by the World Council. Anyhow, this does not overwrite our system. Indeed, it targets IFLA World members under development.

Regional Accreditation and Recognition IMPLIES Global Recognition. This is due to our strong participation.

As a rule of procedure, regional institutions must take the regional pathway, first and foremost, unless special conditions.
