THE CONFERENCE WILL FOCUS ON:

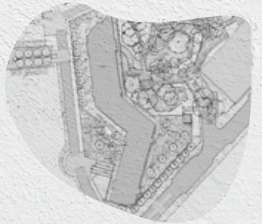
1. The issues and approaches through a multi-disciplinary outlook of varied sciences, research, and demonstrations

We hereby invite national and international Landscape Architects, architects, designers, ecologists, engineers, planners, researchers, scientists and related professionals in academia, research and practice and students from Architecture and related programmes to submit Papers that effectively address the theme of the conference - Unbuilt Landscapes - to inform critical issues and bring forth ideas and inculcating them in our approaches to designing for the future.

SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACT

Interested applicants are invited to initially submit Abstracts for papers related to the theme of the conference under any of the Sub Themes/ tracks listed below. The Abstract needs to be restricted to 400 words. The topics under each sub theme may include but not limited to the following:

- Fringe area amalgamation in the peri-urban and urban areas, greenfield developments, the environmental and socio-cultural impacts of land-use change (towns expanding into their hinterlands, growing/changing economies, industrial occupations and their resource and waste management)

RENEWAL

Decaying cities and renewal by nature

UNBUILDING within the **BUILT**

- Impact of the city on the nature within it - toxic sites, degraded lands, quarries.
- Rejuvenation and restoration of ecological functions, the bringing back of biodiversity

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Please send abstracts of 400 words in length to isolahydcconference@gmail.com
- Abstracts should clearly mention the **SUB THEME Category and Keywords**
- Heading should include the title, author's name, email address, and details on academic/institutional/freelance background
- Please add ISOLA - CALL FOR ABSTRACTS in the subject line of the mail
- Proposals must be submitted electronically and should be presented either in MS Word or PDF format only
- All authors (at least one author in case of Co-Authored papers) will need to register for the conference to ensure inclusion in the programme /publication. Full papers will not be published if the author does not register for the conference, even if the Abstract was selected and Paper is submitted.

PAPER SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- The Paper must be the original work of the author/s
- The format and detailed guidelines for submission of the Final paper shall be intimated upon selection of Abstracts. The Paper must be submitted in the required format only
- All Papers submitted shall be subjected to a process of blind peer review
- An individual is allowed to submit only one Abstract
- In case of multiple authors submitting an abstract, details of all authors, as specified above will need to be mentioned
- The authors will be expected to sign a Grant of Rights Form to ISOLA ONLY for referring or publishing the proceedings of the Conference. A Paper submitted should remain proprietary owned by Author/Authors

- EXHIBITING ENTRIES: ISOLA may offer an opportunity for the selected papers to be exhibited/published at ISOLA CONFERENCE website
