PURPOSE OF THE REPORT.

To update Regional Council on the progress and work done by PPP in 2020/2021

SUMMARY OF THE REPORT (UP TO 100 WORDS).

IFLA APR PPP group worked together on focused activities with Landscape Architects in Asia Pacific Region. From 2020-2021, IFLA APR PPP (Chair, Takanori FUKUOKA) working groups structures are as follows: - Climate Change WG (Representative, Claire Martin), Landscape Architects Without Borders (Representative, Kotchakorn VORAAKHOM), Food and Agriculture (Representative, Misato UEHARA), and EPA (Representative, Reza Lini Anwar) started to develop basic communication with each working groups. In Addition, a few Landscapes Architecture Symposium and Lectures were held as part of IFLA APR PPP activities.

- June 20. 2020-October 2020: U2W (you to world, series of international Landscape Architects talk) started. JLAU IFLA Japan co-hosted this lecture series with IAKS Japan. 10 Lectures were completed, and 80% of participants are in their 20's https://www.facebook.com/LA35Talks/
- September 29, 2020: Tak Fukuoka participated in PALA (Philippine Association of Landscape Architects) online seminar 'New Rules of Engagement: Remote Collaboration in Landscape Architecture
- IFLA APR Cross Talk 2021 will be held in late July and mid-August 2021. The First Cross Talk topic is 'Green Infrastructure in Asia Monsoon Climate' by PPP and the Second Cross Talk topic will be 'Tomodachi Strategies' by LAWB working groups.
